Colons • Practice 1

A colon is used primarily after an independent clause to introduce a list of items. The colon often follows such words as *the following, as follows, these*, or *those*. It is never used with a list that follows a verb or preposition. The colon also has some other uses.

USES OF THE COLON

To introduce a list after an independent clause

corn, peas, or spinach.

To separate hours and minutes

After the salutation in a

business letter

On warnings and labels
