You WILL be graded on ALL of the requirements found below.

Follow the directions below:

1. Close read the text- (20 Points)

Your goal is to fully understand the text when you are finished reading.

- Decide what genre'/subgenre it is and write it down on the article
- Read the entire text one time through-no notes-just read
- Next: Read slowly-close read/analyze one section at a time
- Use our sample as a guide
- Circle 3-4 key words per sentence
- DO NOT** mark entire sentences or phrases of sentences unless Absolutely necessary to show understanding or to quote exact text.
- Write thinking notes/codes/definitions, mini summaries, etc... as you go
- Minimal highlighting!
- Reread/Review the original text to be sure you understand the text.

2. Create a Key Word Outline (KWO) (20 Points)

- Use your sample as a guide
- New number/letter for each paragraph
- Follow the 3-4 words per line rule
- A guideline only: same number of lines of key words as lines in the paragraph. +/-2
- No complete sentences/phrases
- Thinking notes for clarification are ok.
- Place quotation marks around any words/phrases you take directly from text
- Place parenthetical citations next to quoted text if needed

3. Fill in 'Close read of an informational text' WS (10 Points)

- View sample for a model
- Answer author's purpose
- Create a summary statement
- Provide 2 pieces of evidence
- What 2 questions do you still have?

4. Write a paraphrase of the article using only your KWO. (50 Points)

- Do not look at or use the original text
- Break the paraphrase into paragraphs
- Include the key words, your thinking notes, definitions, and your own thoughts to make the paraphrase complete.
- Be absolutely sure you are relaying (retelling) the facts accurately!!**
- Include a variety of sentence openers and patterns-use complex (challenging) patterns too.
- Proof read BEFORE the teacher gets to see it.
- Type it into your google drive
- Title it- Article title name paraphrase
- *Be sure to follow all MLA formatting rules.

Turning in your work: Staple in the following order: (100 Points Total)

- Close read WS (on top)
- Article that has been close read
- KWO
- Paraphrase (should be typed in MLA style)
 - Type in Google Docs
 - Share with Mrs. Stutsman as a "can comment"
